



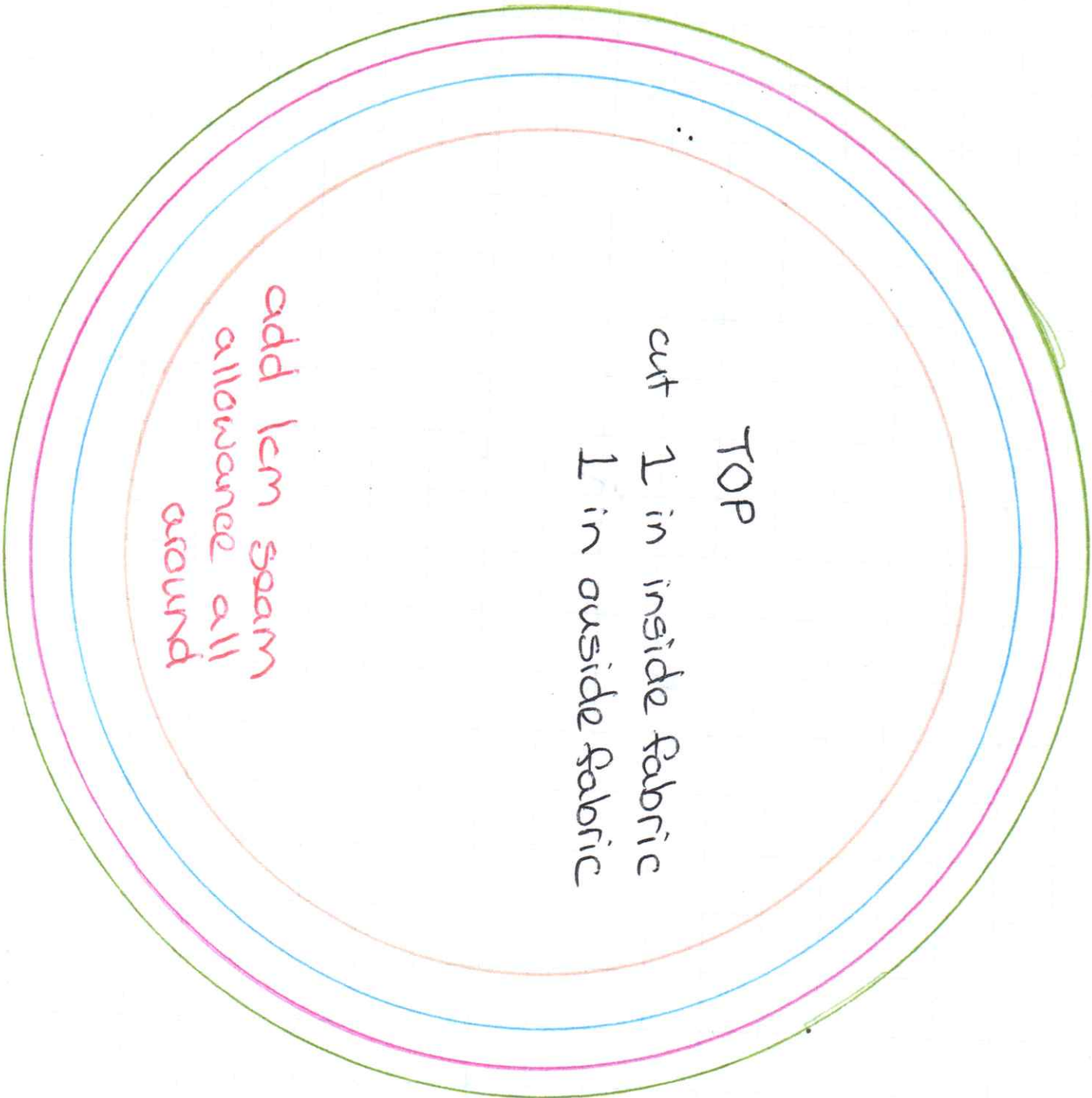

CROWN

cut 1 in inside fabric
1 in outside fabric
in the following sizes
adding 1cm seam
allowance all around

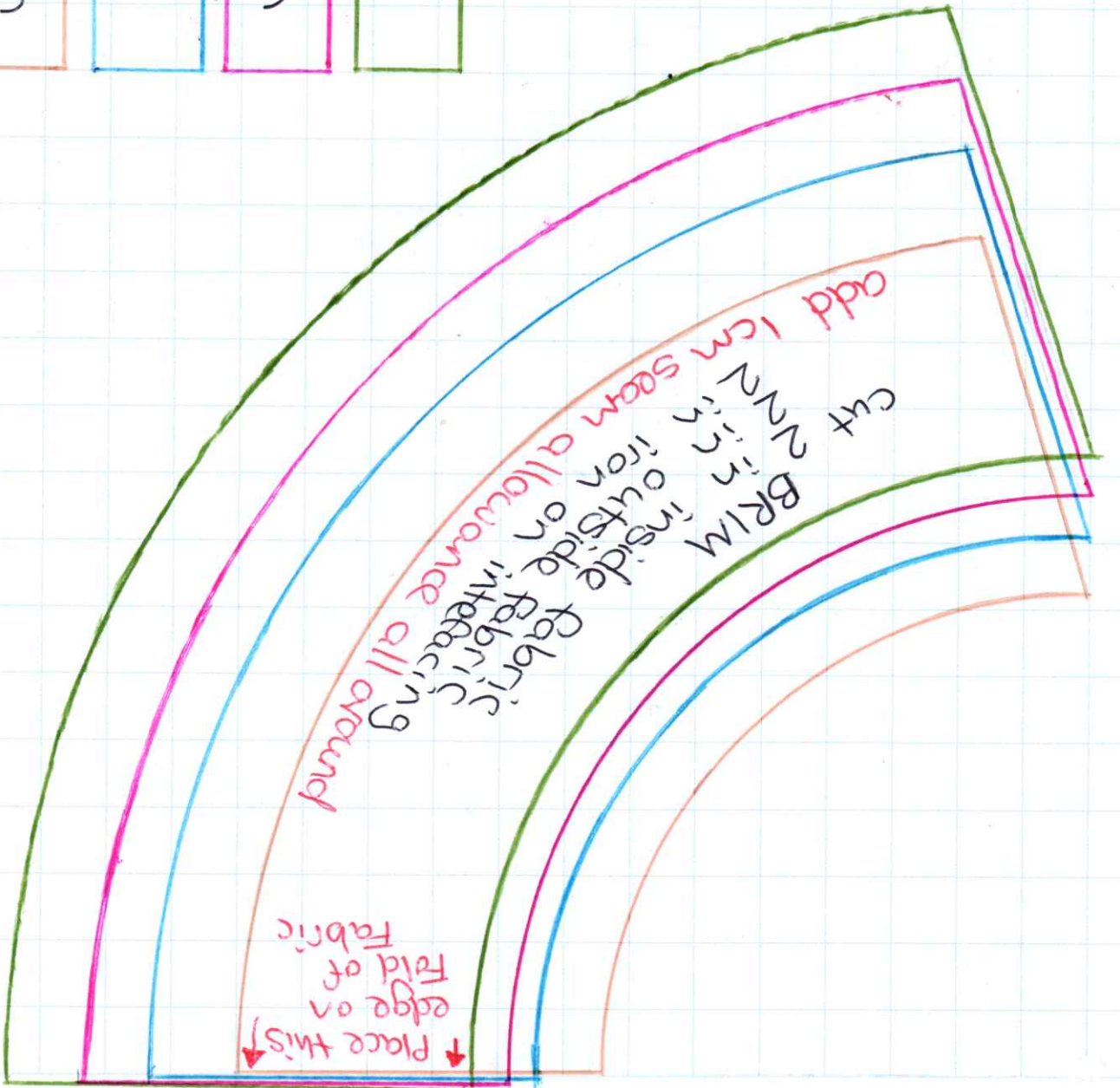
for:

Large 60cm x 9cm

Medium 56cm x 8.5cm

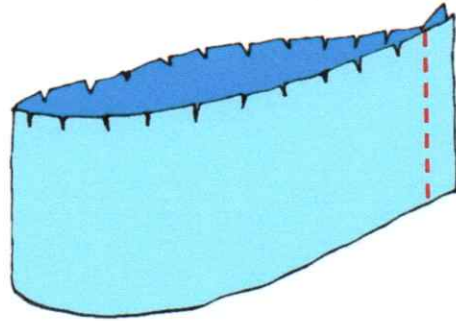
Small 52cm x 8cm

X. Small 48cm x 7cm



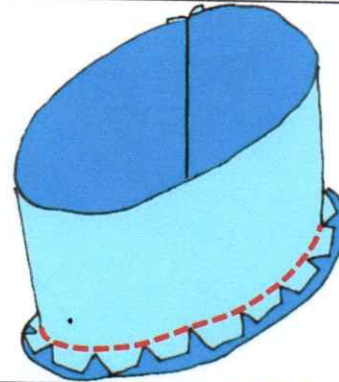
1. Sew short ends of outer crown piece with right sides facing.

2. Snip seam allowance along one long side at 1cm intervals



3. Sew outer top piece to snipped edge with right sides facing.

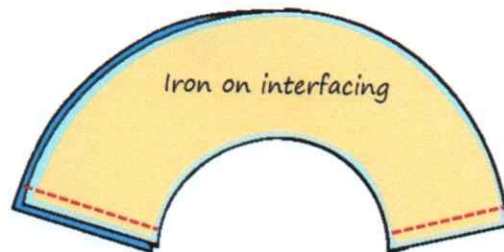
4. Turn the right way around.



5. Iron interfacing on wrong side of outer brim pieces.

6. Sew these pieces together, right sides facing, along short edges.

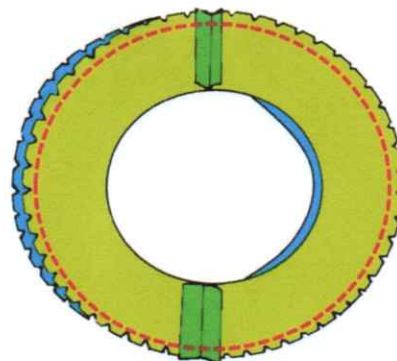
7. Repeat step 6 for inner brim pieces.



8. Sew inner and outer brim together, around the outside edge.

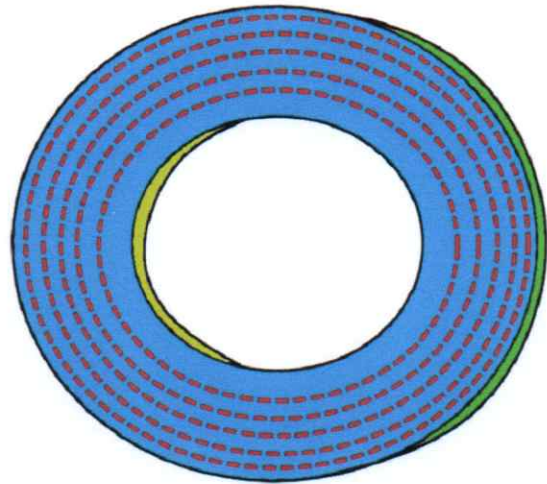
9. Notch the seam allowance around the outside edge at 1.5cm intervals.

10. Turn the brim the right way around



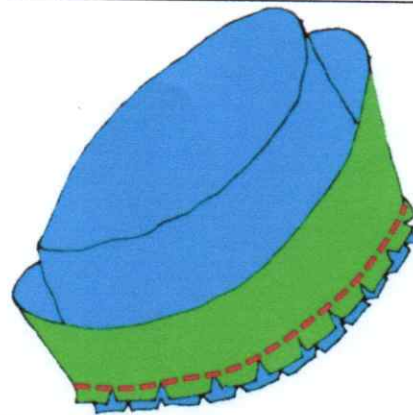
11. Starting from close to the outside edge, top stitch concentric circles around the brim at about 1cm intervals, through all the fabrics.

12. Snip the seam allowance of the inside edge of the brim, through all the fabrics, and the bottom edge of the outer crown, at 1.5cm intervals.



13. With the outer fabrics together, stitch the brim to the outer crown.

14. Repeat steps 1, 2 & 3 for the inner crown.



15. With the inner crown still inside out, put this inside the hat. Tuck the seam allowance in, and hand stitch all around, making sure all the snipped edges are inside.

16. Turn the hat the right way around.
